

All-Star Tumbling Rules and Policies Agreement

Registration Requirements - A parent or legal guardian of child must: (1) Complete a Gymnastics Registration Form, (2) Complete an Autodraft Authorization Payment Form, (3) Pay an Annual Registration Fee, and (4) Pay 1st Month's Tuition.

Class Uniform Requirement – All students are required to wear a uniform to class. Uniforms are \$35 each. To purchase a uniform, please visit our website at www.allstartumbling.org then click on Make Payment. Uniforms will be available within 5 to 10 business days.

Annual Registration Fee – Annual registration fees are due at the time of registration. For all returning students, this fee is due on the student's registration anniversary date. The registration fee schedule is as follows:

1st Child: \$50 2nd Child: \$40 3rd Child: \$30

Tuition Fee – Tuition is due by the 1st of each month. Tuition is based on an average of 4 weeks per session. Some months have five weeks while others have three during the holidays. There is no adjustment to tuition for either case. On a yearly basis, tuition will balance out accordingly. The tuition fee schedule is as follows:

1st Child: \$69 2nd Child: \$64 3rd Child: \$64

Method of Payment – Credit or debit card will be accepted as methods of payment for the first month for new students. Beginning the second month, tuition will be automatically deducted from your credit/card account by Square, Inc. Autodraft Payment Services by the 1st of each month. All first-time registrants must pay the annual registration fee; the 1st month's tuition, and the uniform fee at www.allstartumbling.org.

Returned Credit/Debit Payments – A fee of \$25 will be charged for any returned credit/debit payments.

No Refund Policy – All tuition and fees are non-refundable.

Cancellation – To cancel your child's class participation and to discontinue Autodraft Payment, a 30 day written notice is required. Cancellation requests can be made at info@allstartumbling.org. Absenteeism or no shows will not automatically cancel your child's participation or discontinue Autodraft Payment.

No Make-Up Policy – Make-up classes are not available for classes not attended. There are no refunds, credits, or transfers for missing classes. In the event that classes are canceled due to inclement weather or other circumstances, classes will not be rescheduled.

Holiday Closings – All-Star Tumbling is closed the week of Thanksgiving; Christmas (the week of Christmas and the week after Christmas); New Year's Day; Memorial Day, and Independence Day.

Parent Observation – Parents and guests are to remain in the designated seating areas at all times. No one is allowed on the gymnastics equipment without the permission of the Gymnastics Director. Cell phone ringers and other audio devices must be turned off during practice. Cell phone usage is restricted to emergency calls only.

Restroom Policy – Restrooms are located downstairs in the gym area. Students who have to use the restroom during class time have to be escorted by a parent, coach, or volunteer in the Program.

Class Arrival & Dismissal – Students are expected to use the restroom and change before class begins. All students are to remain seated until their class is called. In the event that no students arrive within 15 minutes of class, practice will be canceled for the day. All-Star Tumbling is not responsible for children left unattended.

Student Conduct – Misconduct will not be tolerated. Any student who is unruly and chooses not to follow the rules will be terminated immediately. Parents will be held responsible for their children's behavior at all times.

Video & Photography – Students enrolled in All-Star Tumbling are subject to have their video or photograph taken by All-Star Tumbling staff members during practice or special events. The resulting video or photograph may be used for any or all advertisement purposes only. Parents and guests are not permitted to video or photograph students during practice.

All-Star Tumbling Policies and Class Schedules are subject to change without notice. A minimum of 3 students must be enrolled to hold a class. It is the parent's responsibility to check the All-Star Tumbling website Event page for special announcements or changes made to the schedule.
